Based between Kapiti and Whanganui, John Girdlestone has been taking photos most of his life as well as working as a production designer in the film industry for 38 years.

With the shift to digital technology he has retained his analogue roots shooting only film on medium and large format cameras.

His work is digitally scanned and printed on Epson Watercolor Radiant White fine art paper with a coated matte surface and an archival permanence of 92 years.

His photography tends to parallel his design for film where his images could be thought of as film sets or locations although they are 'found' rather than created.

He has previously exhibited in a solo exhibition at Photo Space, Wellington and group exhibitions at One Eye Gallery Paekākāriki and Mahara Gallery in Waikanae.

All the photos in this exhibition were printed by DAC Group Limited, Wellington on a HP Latex Wide Format Printer. They have been a leading provider of large format photography and graphics for over 45 years.
